

## **Volunteer Waiver**

THIS VOLUNTEER WAIVER (this “Release”) is executed by the Volunteer identified below, and in the case of a minor, by such minor and his or her legal guardian (the “Volunteer”), in favor of Habitat for Humanity Greater Orlando and Osceola County, Inc., Habitat for Humanity International, Inc., and any other Habitat for Humanity affiliated organization (collectively, “Habitat”).

Volunteer agrees to treat everyone at the volunteer site with respect and will not harass, abuse or insult anyone at the volunteer site. Volunteer will follow all written and verbal safety instructions given by Habitat or its representatives.

**Assumption of the Risk.** Volunteer desires to volunteer for Habitat and understands that this may include engaging in activities at a Habitat office or ReStore, constructing and rehabilitating residential buildings; repairing structures and improvements, and other construction-related activities (collectively, the "Activities"). Volunteer understands that the Activities may be hazardous, and may include construction activities; loading and unloading of heavy items; travel to and from work sites; use of equipment and power tools, and exposure to lead, asbestos, mold or other toxins, which may cause or worsen certain illnesses. Volunteer understands that physical activity, by its very nature, carries with it certain inherent risks that cannot be eliminated regardless of the care taken to avoid injury. Volunteer understands the scope, nature and extent of the risks involved in the Activities and voluntarily agrees to participate with the knowledge of the dangers involved. Volunteer hereby expressly and specifically assume the risk of injury or harm in the Activities and releases Habitat from all liability for any loss, cost, expense, injury, illness, death or property damage resulting directly or indirectly from the Activities.

**Release and Waiver.** Volunteer, individually and on behalf of its spouse, heirs, assign and all persons claiming by, through or under Volunteer, hereby fully and forever releases, acquits, waives and discharges Habitat and any of its owners, members, officers, managers, agents, representatives, partners, members, affiliates, heirs, executors, relatives, administrators, insurers, reinsurers, attorneys, successors, and assigns of any of the foregoing (collectively, “Representatives”), from all manner of actions and causes of action, suits, covenants, liabilities, claims, debts, sums of money, damages, demands, and rights whatsoever, in law or in equity, now existing or which may hereafter accrue in favor of Volunteer from or by reason of any bodily injury or personal injuries, death, loss or theft of personal property or property damage (collectively, “Claims”), arising in connection with the Activities, whether caused wholly or in part by the negligence, fault or misconduct of Habitat or its Representatives. Volunteer covenants that it shall refrain from commencing any action or suit in law or in equity against Habitat or its Representatives with respect to any Claims covered by this Release.

**Medical Treatment.** Volunteer hereby releases and forever discharges Habitat and its Representatives from any Claim arising from any first aid treatment, emergency medical services, or other treatment or service rendered or not rendered to Volunteer by Habitat or its Representatives, as a result of Volunteer’s participation in the Activities.

**Photographic Release & Email Permission.** Volunteer hereby grants and conveys unto Habitat all right, title and interest in any and all photographs and video or audio recordings, and to any royalties, proceeds or other benefits derived therefrom, of Volunteer made by Habitat or its Representatives during the Activities. Volunteer also hereby consents to Habitat sending email messages about Habitat to the email address provided below.

**Other.** Volunteer expressly agree that this Release is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of the State of Florida. Volunteer further agrees that in the event any provision of this Release is held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, that invalidity shall not otherwise affect the remaining provisions, which shall continue to be enforceable. Further, a waiver of a right under this Release does not prevent the exercise of any other right.

## Guardian Waiver for Minor

The legal guardian hereby joins the Release and hereby releases and forever discharges Habitat and its Representatives from any Claim identified in the Release. The legal guardian hereby covenants and agrees to indemnify and hold Habitat and its Representatives harmless from and against the Claims of any other legal guardian of Volunteer.
